- like



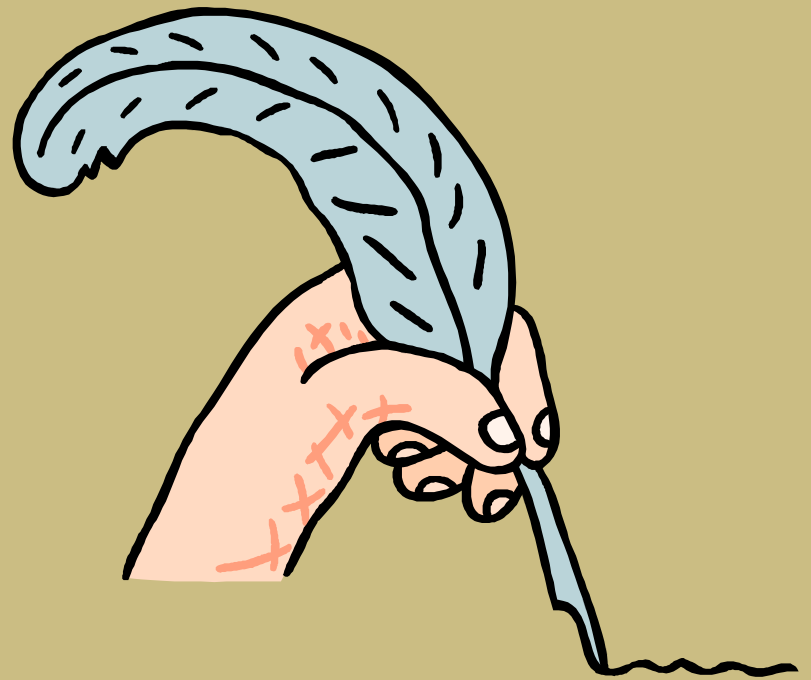

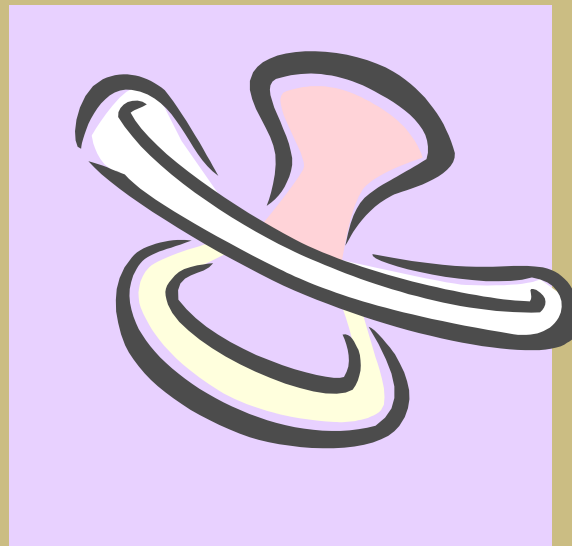

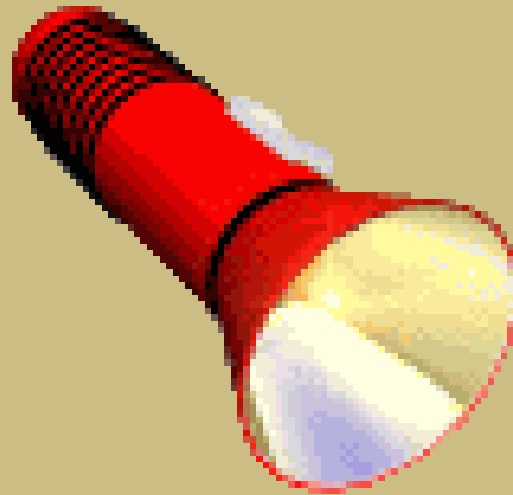
