For the next two weeks I have used a pack from a website called Classroom Secrets. I have created a username and password for every member of the class so they can login and access the website. There are lots of different games, tutorials and quizzes that look interesting and all are suitable to the Year 1 curriculum.

Username: 339178+your child's name with a capital letter e.g. 339178Danny

Password: green

I have an overview of the class so will be able to see the games the pupils have completed and the progress they are making.

### Lexia

If your child uses Lexia then this is a fantastic resource to keep using at home. Lexia can be accessed by the LexiaCore5 website: <https://www.lexiacore5.com/> For first time users at home the school email address is: [GreenlaneSA@durham.sch](mailto:GreenlaneSA@durham.sch) and the username is your child's first name and the first letter of their surname e.g. Tom Brown is tomb and the password is green.

Level 5 is classed as the end of Year 1 so it may be, as time goes on, that if your child has completed up to the end of their year group they will need to be removed from Lexia to allow other pupils in the school to be able to use it. I will let you know if this is the case.
